You know what we as a Lodge do, we support the FBMA, Mooseheart, and most important Moosehaven. We do this through Endowment Fund collections on Friday nights in the social quarters while having a good time, and during meetings and gatherings of our members. One thing I will say is this Lodge of 450 men members

and several hundred women members step up, and support whatever charity needs to be taking care of. I am proud to say that, and do say that, to anyone I have a chance to. I received a letter from Moose International yesterday. It thanks us for paying our obligations to Moose International on time and in full. I don't know that all of you understand, we not only send endowment to them, but we also pay our insurances through Moose. Moose International is self-insured for the first few millions of liability. If I'm not mistaken I think we're the only fraternal order that is self-insured in this way. Making it important for us to make our payments on time. What I'm getting at, is without you, the members supporting The Palm Bay Moose Lodge this would not be possible, so I thank you for coming in and supporting us, The Palm Bay Moose Lodge.

We just had a very good District 7 meeting in our Lodge. It will be the last one as District 7, from now on we will be considered District 6. This will begin in September. Merritt Island Lodge, along with Cocoa Lodge will be joining us in the new District. The bad part is we are losing Vero Beach will be in District 5, I myself love driving down to Vero Beach.
