Raising over \$200, 000 for Special Olympics Programs throughout Florida. Sponsored by SeaWorld and the Florida Professional Firefighters, this annual event has grown

and has raised over 1.6 Million Dollars since starting in 2009. The Florida Bermuda Moose Association supports this Heart of the Community event by promoting participation through its members. For them, they are challenged with raising enough funds to qualify and spreading the news about what Special Olympics does. Special Olympics was founded in 1968 to provide year-round sports training and competition to children and adults with intellectual disabilities, at no cost to the athlete or their caregiver, as a means to achieve physical fitness, self-esteem, socialization skills, and the life skills necessary to be a productive, respected and contributing members of their communities. This year one of our Lodges and Chapters sponsor two Special Olympics Athletes into the plunge, they joined our team and took to



the water like heroes! Thanks to the Zephyrhills Moose Lodge and Chapter. Showing what many hands can do to make a difference in someone's life. As the fun continued all day, our Palm Bay team racked up over \$2000 in donations. All for Special Olympic Athletes in Florida. 



REMEMBER PALM BAY'S FALLEN PUBLIC SERVANTS **29 YEAR ANNIVERSARY, APRIL 23 10AM**

These two officers made the ultimate sacrifice when they went to work on April 23, 1987. A lone gunman, firing on civilians, was confronted by these officers. Officer Ronald Grogan placed his vehicle between the gunman and fleeing civilians. Taking on bullets, he never made it out of the car. Officer Gerald Johnson was returning fire, trying to protect himself and fellow officers, he was struck and killed. Our community owes a debt of gratitude for their sacrifice, saving many peoples lives. Last summer the Palm Bay Moose performed a park project that included refreshing a monument built in their honor. The City of Palm Bay is working on renewing the signs that were part of the display. Please join us at this Monument located in Oakwood Park, 490 Koutnik Road SE, Palm Bay 32909, on April 23 @ 10 AM, to remember our fallen heroes. We will hold a small ceremony and a moment of silence for these officers.
